HipHop Shakespeare Project

Shakespeare North Playhouse have commissioned Hip-Hop artist Nikki Blaze to create a comprehensive digital resource exploring the similarities between Hip-Hop and Shakespeare. This resource will include instructional films, lesson plans and musical stimulus.

Aimed at Key Stage 2 and 3 students, classes will be encouraged to write together and develop their written and performance skills.

Representatives from each of our partner schools are invited to attend a CPD session at the theatre in July to learn more about this resource and how to use it.

Throughout the academic year, we will have a range of CPD sessions available to schools and teachers. These sessions will explore a variety of topics, using Shakespeare as the key to unlocking the curriculum in creative and engaging ways.

Additional projects

Throughout the year, we plan to develop additional projects with our partner organisations that involve school engagement. These opportunities will only be offered to our partner schools.

Early access to theatre tickets

Our partner schools will be notified in advance of tickets going on sale to the general public so that they are able to book sufficient numbers for class visits.
