The Cockpit Theatre is a traditional 470 seat timber framed Shakespearean theatre, a replica of a 17th century theatre which existed in Whitehall, London in the 17th century.

Watching a production in this intimate space is a unique and unforgettable experience. As well as the architectural and historic significance, the productions bring Shakespeare's work to life in exciting ways and present fascinating stories inspired by The Bard.

This package will provide your students and staff with a memorable experience of world class theatre on their doorstep. Included is a class visit to see a performance in our Cockpit Theatre for up to 36 people (32 students and 4 staff).

We offer a variety of informative and creative sessions which can be delivered at your school as part of an INSET day or as a twilight session.

This package includes a 2-hour session for up to 30 teachers, delivered at school or at Shakespeare North Playhouse, as well as teaching resources to use back in the classroom.

Bard across the Board Cross-Curricular Shakespeare (2 hours)

If you thought Shakespeare was just for English and Drama lessons, thou art mistaken. It's surprising what the bard can bring to every subject! Perfect for topic, theme and project-based learning this session explores making connections between Shakespeare and Citizenship, History, Geography, Art and even Maths and Science!

Creative Approaches to Revision (2 hours)

As exam time approaches, join us for a session exploring ways of supporting students through revising Shakespeare texts, with ideas to inspire even the most reluctant of learners to reconnect with the plays, study independently and develop understanding.

Words and Wellbeing (2 hours)

Join us for a relaxing session of reading and reflection as we explore a timeless Shakespeare text to inspire a personal creative response, modelling an approach to encourage positive thinking and expression.

Shakespeare Off the Page (2 hours)

A session exploring dynamic ways of bringing Shakespeare to life in the classroom. Gain ideas to enrich your lessons with interactive activities and creative approaches to studying his work, as well as trying drama and rehearsal room techniques to engage and inspire students of all ages and abilities.

Life-long Learning (2 hours)

Learn how to build discussion and reflection into your lessons in order to develop lifelong learning skills and student resilience. You will leave the session with a visual creative record of the techniques discussed.

2024 Additional project

Our Town's Sound is a project exploring the heritage of local language. Inspired by our wonderful First Folio exhibition, this project is designed to capture the essence of language specific to Knowsley and the surrounding areas.

From local industry to migration, social structure to popular culture, many factors can influence language development, creating colloquialisms specific to a place.

We will be working with the local community, supported by artists and heritage specialists, to dive into local slang and uncover conversational gems.



All partner schools will be offered workshop sessions as part of the project, with the focus on getting students excited about local history, spoken word and writing.
