COMEDY

What role does it play in Shakespeare's works? Explore Shakespeare's silliest plots and characters through drama games and creative activities.

FINDING YOUR VOICE

Build confidence, develop selfexpression, and practice speaking aloud.

Take a tour of our theatre, including backstage areas and our Cockpit Theatre, followed by a session in the Learning Centre exploring creative industry career pathways.

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CONTINUING Professional Development (CPD)

Empowering educators with innovative tools and strategies, our Continuing Professional Development workshops are designed to inspire teaching excellence and enhance classroom impact.

Each of our professional development packages offers a focused 2 hour session for up to 30 teachers, delivered at your school or at Shakespeare North Playhouse, along with valuable teaching resources to use in the classroom.

BARD ACROSS THE BOARD CROSS-CURRICULAR SHAKESPEARE

Ideal for topic-, theme-, and project-based learning, we'll explore connections between Shakespeare and Citizenship, History, Geography, Art, and even Maths and Science.

Unwind with a session of reading and reflection, using a timeless Shakespeare text to inspire personal creativity. This workshop models an approach to encourage positive thinking and self-expression, perfect for student wellbeing.
