


The Cockpit Theatre is a stunning 470-seat, timber-framed venue, modelled after a 17th-century Shakespearean theatre once found in Whitehall, London. Watching a performance in this intimate, historically significant space is a truly unique experience. Our productions bring Shakespeare's work to life in exciting ways, while also telling captivating stories inspired by The Bard.

The program culminates in a final sharing event at Shakespeare North Playhouse, where selected students perform their work before an audience.
